Venue Ambassador - Ambassadors manage all venue volunteer activities and communicate to the Volunteer Chair when volunteers have been posted during shift changes, radio and counter assignment and venue needs.

Venue Greeter - Greet festival attendees, confirm access with correct festival pass, and use a counter to keep track of the number of festival attendees entering the venue. Crowd capacity must be ensured to NOT exceed venue limitations.

Volunteer Hospitality Host(ess) - The host/hostess will check in all volunteers 30 minutes before their shift time begins, provide them with a name badge, remind them of their shift responsibilities, and tally their sheets.

Artist Hospitality - Greet Jazz Festival artists and ensure only artists, caterers and authorized festival personnel have access to the space.

Merchandise - Assist with T-shirt and poster sales. May assist with stocking inventory and customer purchases.

Courtesy Cart Driver - Will drive a golf cart and offer rides to EJF attendees to different venues. Valid License and Proof of Insurance required.
