

### **REMEMBERING PAUL THOMAS**

October 13, 1923 - April 15, 2023 (age 99)



Paul Thomas was a graduate of Elkhart High School 1941 class and attended Indiana University, where he was a yell leader and band member for both.

Paul, affectionately known as the "Mayor of Main Street" worked as the manager of Drakes Department store in Elkhart until he opened his own business, Paul Thomas Shoes, in Downtown Elkhart in 1955. The store was well known for its tiny door that welcomed thousands of children over the years.

Paul had numerous contributions to his community. He served 2 terms on council for the City of Elkhart, was a 62-year member and past president of the Elkhart Lions Club, receiving the Citizen of the Year of Elkhart. Paul also received the Sagamore of the Wabash Award from then Governor Frank O'Bannon in 1996.

He loved sharing the rich history of Elkhart with others. Following his retirement from Thomas Shoes in 1988, he founded the Time Was Museum which gave him the opportunity to share the history of Elkhart, often giving programs to student groups, service clubs, and libraries.

Paul was a passionate supporter of Downtown Elkhart and was one of the founders of the Elkhart Jazz Festival. The Jazz Festival was his favorite downtown event. The performances he looked forward to the most were those of, his favorite jazz artist, Joan Collaso.

Paul was well known for driving a golf cart around downtown, often not paying much attention because he was too busy greeting everyone he encountered. He never met a stranger, now remembering their names was a different story. Paul once picked a visitor up from The Lerner on his golf cart to take him to The Knights of Columbus. When they arrived, the visitor looked at Paul and said "this is the most unique city I have ever been to", Paul asked him why. The visitor responded that "everyone in this city is named Bud or Hun". Even after he stopped driving the cart, you could find Paul sitting near the welcome area so he could greet everyone. His uniform, a green blazer, made him easy to find and recognized by guests.

Paul, a legend in the "City with a Heart", was a true champion for the City of Elkhart and cheerleader for the festival.

This one is for you Paul!



### ANDY BROWN TRIO

Andy Brown is a guitarist based in Chicago. Born in New York in 1975, he has played professionally for thirty years. He has had a varied performing career that has included stints in Cincinnati and New York City. He has been called a "superior mainstream guitarist" in Downbeat magazine.

Since coming to Chicago in 2003, Andy has been fortunate to work at many of the area's finest jazz venues with his own bands, as well as playing his unique brand of solo jazz guitar. He has backed visiting jazz names at places including The Jazz Showcase and Ravinia. Currently he plays solo guitar every Thursday at The Green Mill, leads his quartet weekly at Andy's Jazz Club and performs with his group regularly at Winter's Jazz Club. As a sideman he has performed with internationally known jazz musicians including Scott Hamilton, Howard Alden, Harry Allen, Warren Vaché, Ken Peplowski, Hod O'Brien, Michael Feinstein and many others. He also had the good fortune to accompany Barbra Streisand when she appeared on the Oprah Winfrey Show in 2009. Andy has made many festival appearances around the world including performances in Brazil, Europe and Canada. In 2012, his trio was invited by the Chicago Mayor's office to perform for the Nobel Peace Prize dinner in Chicago where invited guests included U.S. presidents Bill Clinton and Jimmy Carter, as well as the Dalai Lama and Mikhail Gorbachev.

Since 2009, Andy has co-led a two-guitar quartet with renowned guitarist Howard Alden. Andy had the good fortune to learn directly from several guitar masters, including Cal Collins, Ted Greene, and Howard Alden. His most important mentor was the late Kenny Poole, who called Andy his protégé.

Ben has been active gigging around the Indianapolis area, recently performing at the historic Chatterbox Jazz Club in Indianapolis with trumpeter and mentor Mark Buselli. He has also had the incredible honor of performing at Dizzy's Club Coca-Cola in NYC with the Ball State Jazz Ensemble.

A student of Indianapolis-based pianist Dr. Scott

Routenberg, his creativity extends beyond just the keyboard, showing a knack for writing catchy melodies as a composer/arranger for small and large ensembles. His talents have earned him the Tom Shah Jazz Scholarship during his time at Ball State.

### CHRISTOPHER LUCAS WILSON TRIO

Christopher Lucas Wilson is a hard swingin' pianist originally from metropolitan Detroit, later transplanted to Los Angeles, and recently relocated to Chicago. As a child, Christopher was first introduced to music on a Grinnell Brothers piano in his parents' living room by a now unknown piano teacher. Although this teacher's name remains a mystery, Christopher remains indebted for his role in instilling a lifelong passion for music. The enlightening and freeing sound of swing is what first attracted Christopher to jazz. His interest in this feeling is what led him to begin exploring Detroit's rich musical history which was and is replete with musical legends. He first studied with the late greats Bess Bonnier and Marcus Belgrave. Later, he would join the Detroit Symphony Orchestra's Civic Jazz Program where he first met esteemed bassist and educator Rodney Whitaker. By the time Christopher graduated from high school, he was entrenched in swing and bebop and would go on to further his studies within the jazz program at Michigan State University. While at Michigan State, he had the pleasure of studying and performing with Rodney Whitaker, Wess "Warmdaddy" Anderson, Derrick Gardner, Vincent Chandler, Randy Gilespie, Diego Rivera, and Rick Roe. After graduating Christopher immediately began performing with his trio in Detroit, including a weekly jam session at the heralded Baker's

Keyboard Lounge. A short year later, Christopher relocated to sunny swingin' Los Angeles where he fell in love with Southern California and spent nearly a decade there as a result. During that time he played regularly with his trio and released two albums, "Feelin' Better" and "Leaving Los Angeles." Christopher moved to Chicago shortly after and is honored and excited to be part of another incredible city rich with musical history. Christopher's music is highly influenced by hard swing, bebop, and the rich history of jazz piano trios. His focus is the uplifting nature of swing and the beauty behind the jazz piano trio. His arrangements are thoughtful and his music contagious.

Growing up in a family of talented singers and musicians, Darryl first started playing the bass and guitar at age 12. At age 17 he was discovered by the legendary Motown recording artist Jr. "Shotgun" Walker and started doing world tours in the early 1980's. Through out his musical career he toured for over 20 years with many legendary groups including, The Temptations Grammy Award winner Richard Street, former legendary James Brown band director Trombonist Fred Wesley of the JB's, and the Motown Revue. In 1993 while a member of the Jr. Walker's band, Darryl had the honor to perform at President Bill Clinton's Inaugural Ball. Darryl has also performed on numerous TV shows including NBC's Saturday Night Live and has performed at the world famous Apollo Theatre in Harlem, NY.

His smooth vocal style fits the legendary sounds of artist like Smokey Robinson and Al Green. Darryl Buchanan is currently producing R&B, Pop and Gospel music with various artist. On August

## DAVINA AND THE VAGABONDS

New spin on an old sound, Davina and The Vagabonds have created a stir on the international music scene with their high-energy live shows and commanding stage presence. Davina Sowers as been compared to Etta James, Amy Winehouse, Janis Joplin, Billie Holiday and Betty Boop, but comparisons don't suffice: she is a true original. Bringing you 100 years of American music and Davina's originals, which lend themselves to the American Songbook, the band brings edgy nostalgia to older generations and fresh new music to younger ears. This rollicking quintet is held together by Sowers' keyboard playing, with acoustic bass, drums, and a spicy trumpet and trombone horn section. The group's focused, clean sound and emphasis on acoustic instruments is novel to both blues and jazz worlds, and sets the show closer to New Orleans than to Chicago.

# DAVE BENNETT QUARTET

Presented by

Dave Bennett doesn't fit the mold. For starters, you don't find many jazz clarinet players who name Alice Cooper, Stevie Ray Vaughan, and Chris Isaak among their influences. You won't find many musicians who are equally conversant with the music of Benny Goodman (the "King of Swing") and Roy Orbison ("The Soul of Rock and Roll"). In fact, you may not find even one other clarinet virtuoso who breaks from his Swing Era repertoire to sing rockabilly hits while accompanying himself at the piano or electric guitar. Dave Bennett fuses serious jazz improvisation with a host of modern pop influences.

Dave began his national touring career at the age of 14. He has been a featured soloist at Carnegie Hall with The New York Pops (2013) and has been featured with 35 other US and Canadian orchestras including Nashville, Detroit, Rochester, Omaha, Toronto, Calgary, Vancouver, Orlando, San Antonio, Jacksonville, Portland, OR and Portland, ME. Some of his annual appearances include The Elkhart Jazz Festival, The Suncoast Classic Jazz Festival, The Arizona Classic Jazz Festival, The Sacramento Hot Jazz Jubilee, The Clambake Music Festival, and The Redwood Coast Music Festival.

Dave has been featured on NPR Radio's "Jazz at Riverwalk." He made his European debut in 2008 at The Bern Jazz Festival (Switzerland) in a combo with jazz legends and Benny Goodman band alumni guitarist Bucky Pizzarelli and vibraphonist, the late Peter Appleyard. In March 2022, Dave and his band performed to a sold-out audience at New York City's Birdland Theatre.Dave is a Mack Avenue Records artist. His 2013 CD "Don't Be That Way" met with critical acclaim. His second release, Blood Moon, which features five originals and six pop/jazz covers, reached No 24 on the Billboard Jazz charts in 2018.


During the isolation of the pandemic, fate steered Dave's time off the road into a bold new direction. He put his guitar pedal to the metal and stepped away from his beloved clarinet. A songwriter stepped forward. Road songs, reverb-laded guitar solos that could power a surf documentary, and memories of loves and lives lost are the mile markers that makeup his latest release "Nowhere Fast". Leave it to Dave Bennett to prove that sometimes the best way to move forward is to go back to the beginnings of what drives you.







# LAO TIZER QUARTET

Hailing from Boulder, CO, with a career that now spans nine albums over nearly a quarter of a century -- he was a teenage prodigy -- Tizer is the son of hippies with a Russian-Jewish background, and the mix of that ethnic family heritage, parental new age influence and growing up with the sights and sounds of '80s and '90s pop culture (alongside the music of the '60s and '70s he heard from his parents) have brought him to a place in his artistic life where he was ready to embrace a wider range of influences and stretch himself and his players to pull off such an ambitious project one all my life."

If the choice of Led Zeppelin's "Ramble On," U2's "Pride (In The Name Of Love)," and Cat Stevens' "Sad Lisa" seem astonishing, Tizer's arrangements render them almost entirely original. They are taken to the transcendent through the warm and soulful vocals of Tita Hutchison, who sang with the likes of Michael McDonald, Rick Rubin, Michael Jackson, and Foreigner, among others.


Hutchison joins Tizer's regular collaborators who are celebrated in their own right: Chieli Minucci, the three-time Emmy-winning and Grammy® Award-nominated guitarist and composer;

Grammy® Award-winning saxophonist Eric Marienthal, who is a permanent member of the Chick CoreaElektric Band; longtime member and EWI/saxophonist/multi-instrumentalist Steve Nieves; and violinist Karen Briggs, who has graced the stage with Yanni, Diana Ross, Wu-Tang Clan, Chaka Khan and more. Tizer also credits the powerhouse rhythm section (bass players include Grammy® Award-nominee Ric Fierabracci and Cheikh NDoye, Grammy® Award-nominated drummer Gene Coye, and percussionist Munyungo Jackson) with underpinning the dynamic force and arrangements for the project

The group in fact stretches to 15 members at times with the addition of a string quartet, horn section and a marimba player. Just watching the video of "Metropolis" shows the vast ambitiousness of the undertaking, the concentration of so many musicians in the studio playing live together and feeding into work that was so much grander than the breathtaking individual performances, while the sultry and intimate duet -- just piano and violin -- on "Forever Searching" reminds the listener and viewer of the purity of Tizer's jazz beginnings.

Led by the multiple award-winning 18-year-old bass phenom Gabriel Severn, with Connor Rohrer on keys and Logan Bedard on drums, the trio has taken audiences by storm with their energy, talent, and undeniable chemistry. They were recognized by the Central Pennsylvania Music Hall of Fame with the "2020 Best Jazz Artist" Award. Performing original compositions as well as covers, they weave jazz, funk, rock, and world rhythms into tunes by luminaries such as the Average White Band, Weather Report, and the Yellowjackets.

Bands from the golden era of fusion influenced Severn's earliest musical sensibilities. Before forming Teen Town, it was a challenge for him to find other musicians around his age (12) who wanted to experiment with jazz fusion. After meeting then 16-year-old Rohrer and 14-year-old Bedard at a jazz camp, the three were immediately on board with the idea.

Teen Town has been together for six years, but if you close your eyes, you'd think it's been decades.

They cut their teeth on tunes from the bands they admire, such as Weather Report's "Havona" and the namesake tune, "Teen Town". Over time the trio has found their own voice and compositional style, and their long-awaited debut album, A Month of Sundays, was released in 2022.

Teen Town has supported headliners including Sheila E., the Victor Wooten Trio, and the Tierney Sutton Band, and appeared at multiple festivals including the Berks Jazz Fest, the Dauphin County Wine & Jazz Festival, and the Elkhart Jazz Festival. They've appeared on ABC TV and NPR radio and led music education clinics.

The trio has been described as "a tribute to the golden era of fusion hitting the improvisational buffet at a dance party".




